What data do we collect?

Footstars CIC collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (parent name, child's name, child's date of birth, contact email address, contact phone number)
- Relevant medical information
- Consent for photos and videos for promotional purposes

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Footstars CIC with the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Enroll your child prior to starting with us

How will we use your data?

Footstars CIC collects your data so that we can:

- Enroll your child, manage your account.
- Email you with information on other products and services we believe may be of interest to you.

How do we store your data?

Footstars CIC securely stores your data on an online drive which is password protected and only available to Footstars employees.

Footstars CIC will keep your data for three year period. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data if your child is no longer enrolled with us.

Marketing

Footstars CIC would like to send you information about products and services of ours that we believe may be of interest to you.

You have the right at any time to stop Footstars CIC from contacting you for marketing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

Footstars CIC would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request Footstars CIC for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Footstars CIC correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Footstars CIC to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erase – You have the right to request that Footstars CIC erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Footstars CIC restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Footstars CIC processing your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Footstars CIC transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please contact us via email on Info@Footstars.org.uk
